Administrative Regulation for Home School Students

Elkin Middle School

Elkin Middle School encourages home school students to take advantage of courses offered on its campus to increase their opportunities for academic and social involvement. Students enrolling on a part-time basis must meet the following requirements:

-Be enrolled at least part-time (180 minutes of the school day).

-Provide documentation of home school enrollment and attendance.

-Provide documentation to meet any stated prerequisite for courses selected.

-Must follow ECS and EMS policies for attendance, behavior, grade, and testing.

In order to be eligible to participate in extracurricular activities, including athletics, students must pass a minimum of 3 core classes as set by NCDPI.

Home school students who are domiciled within the Elkin City Schools attendance area are eligible to enroll as part-time students at Elkin Middle School and receive credit for courses offered in its regular pattern at no cost. Home school students who are domiciled outside the Elkin City Schools attendance area must be approved for enrollment by the principal and pay the required out-of-district tuition fees.

Elkin High School

Elkin High School encourages home school students to take advantage of courses offered on its campus to increase their opportunities for academic and social involvement. Students enrolling on a part-time basis must meet the following requirements:

-Be enrolled in at least 2 courses per semester.

-Provide documentation of home school enrollment and attendance.

-Provide documentation to meet any stated prerequisite for courses selected.

-Must follow ECS and EHS policies for attendance, behavior, grading, and testing.

In order to be eligible to participate in extracurricular activities, including athletics, students must pass a minimum of 3 classes at EHS and must meet all NCHSAA requirements.

Home school students who are domiciled within the Elkin City Schools attendance area are eligible to enroll as part-time students at Elkin High School and receive credit for courses offered in its regular pattern at no cost. Home school students who are domiciled outside the Elkin City Schools attendance area must be approved for enrollment by the principal and pay the required out-of-district tuition fees.
