

Students shall not at school (including during participation in virtual educational activities), at school-sponsored activities, or through their Elkin City Schools email accounts, display or transmit in any medium, writings, images, or symbols that are reasonably expected to be divisive, demeaning, or offensive to any person or group, or disruptive to the learning environment, including, but not limited to, writings, images, or symbols (1) that are associated with hate groups, (2) that are obscene, slanderous, or libelous, (3) that are associated with intimidation, violence, or groups that advocate intimidation or violence, (4) that advocate racial, ethnic, or religious prejudice (for example, items that promote intolerance or confrontation, including the confederate flag or swastika), or (5) that denigrate others on the basis of race, color, religion, creed, national origin, gender, sexual orientation, or disability. Images and symbols covered by this policy are permissible in libraries or approved learning materials, or in classroom settings as part of a learning assignment supervised by a teacher.
